GUIDELINE FOR REGISTRATION AND ACTIVITIES IN WASH SECTOR IN GOMBE STATE

OVERVIEW:

In accordance with the Gombe State Water Board mandate; is authorized to collect, Test, Analyze, Treat and Register all water boreholes/facilities in the urban areas of the State. As well as to maintain a comprehensive registry of boreholes/facilities and other WASH projects.

Note: All associated charges/fees should be paid to: Gombe state Government's TSA revenue account, Using Remita payable at any Bank

2	borehole drilling activities without approval shall be liable to a default fee of N10,000 Drilling Permit:	24hours	N10,000 to the State TSA account
	 Obtain permit from GSWB HQ before embarking on drilling of borehole in the urban center. Then GSWB will carry out necessary inspection at the location where the borehole will be located to determine the proximity of the borehole to underground water pollution. 		and evidence of payment presented at GSWB HQ. Penalty of N20,000 is imposed on default
	Note: This permit may be denied after necessary inspection is carried out or as a result of proximity to underground water pollution source.

	 Borehole owners are to register their boreholes with GSWB by paying a onetime fee paid into Gombe State TSA account and evidence of payment presented at the GSWB headquarters or by email to gswbcustomercare@gmail.com This is mandatory for all borehole owners (both for unregistered boreholes and new boreholes). 7	Annual physiochemical & bacteriological Analysis	48hours	N50,000
	 The GSWB will conduct physiological and bacteriological laboratory testing of water from the boreholes to meet the Nigerian Standard of Drinking Water Quality. Also, GSWB quality control officer will collect water sample on yearly basis to ascertain safety for human consumption. 		
8	Registration of borehole drillers	3 days	N10,000

	 To register as borehole drillers and operate within the state for the purpose of data collection, competence, monitoring and adherence to guidelines, borehole drillers shall make a payment of N10,000 Submit evidence of payment at the GSWB headquarters or by email to gswbcustomercare@gmail.com 		Penalty of N20,000 is imposed on default
9	 Registration of private laboratories Private Labs operating within the state must register with GSWB for assessment adherence of water quality standard guidelines, knowledge sharing and approval to carry out water sample analysis. To register, payment of N5,000 shall be made to the State TSA account and evidence of payment receipt shall be submitted at GSWB headquarters or emailed to gswbcustomercare@gmail.com 	3 days	N5,000 Penalty of N10,000 is imposed for illegal operation
10	Registration of fecal sludge evacuators Fecal sludge evacuator must register with GSWB sewerage services department to ensure adherence to Fecal Sludge Management and safety procedures	3 days	N30,000 Penalty of N60,000 is imposed for illegal operators
11	 Registration of Water bottling companies All water bottling companies must register with GSWB for inspection and certification. Payment of N50,000 shall be made to the State TSA account and evidence of payment receipt shall be submitted at GSWB headquarters or emailed to gswbcustomercare@gmail.com 	3 days	N50,000 Penalty of N100,000 is imposed for illegal operation
12	Registration of Water Sachet producers: All water bottling companies must register with GSWB for inspection and certification. Payment of N25,000 shall be made to the State TSA account and evidence of payment receipt shall be submitted at GSWB headquarters or emailed to gswbcustomercare@gmail.com	3 days	N25,000. Penalty of N50,000 is imposed for illegal operation
13	Registration of public Sanitation facilities operators This is to ensure adherence to best practices and proper awareness on is created eradicate open defecation in the state. Payment of N10,000 shall be made to the State TSA account and evidence of payment receipt shall be submitted at GSWB headquarters or emailed to gswbcustomercare@gmail.com	3 days	N10,000. Penalty of N20,000 is imposed on default
