PROCEDURE FOR OBTAINING A VEHICLE INSPECTION CERTIFICATE (ROAD WORTHINESS)

GUIDING LAW & REGULATIONS

In line with the provisions of the Federal Road Safety Commission (Establishment) Act, 2007, and the National Road Traffic Regulations (2004), all vehicles in Nigeria must meet specific safety and environmental standards to ensure roadworthiness. The Federal Road Safety Commission (FRSC), along with relevant state authorities, is empowered to regulate and enforce these standards, issuing Vehicle Inspection Certificates to confirm that a vehicle is fit for road use.

All individuals and organizations seeking to obtain Vehicle Inspection Certificate (VIC) from Gombe State can apply through the following process;

Step 1: Prepare the following relevant documents;

- Vehicle purchase receipt
- Customs Clearance Certificate
- Proof of Ownership Certificate
- Evidence of Corporate Affair Registration CAC (For fleet)
- Tax Clearance Certificate (TCC) and Tax Identification Number [TIN] (for all forms of
- business).

Step 2: Pay applicable fee

Payment can be made across the following channels:

- TSA Online payment platform via Pay a biller (remita.net)
- Make payment through <u>www.irs.gm.gov.ng</u>
- Pay Inspection charges (see below) at Customer Service Centre located at the Ministry of Housing & Transport, Jekadafari Road, Gombe, Gombe State. Upon payment, applicants will instantly be issued a Receipt.

Step 4: Submit relevant documents

Kindly present original copies and submit copies of documents listed in step 1 above, together with Receipt in Step 3 above to the Ministry of Housing & Transport, Jekadafari Road, Gombe, Gombe State

Step 5: Vehicle Inspection

Kindly drive your vehicle to the Ministry of Housing & Transport, Jekadafari Road, Gombe, Gombe State for inspection.

Vehicles will be inspected within **24 hours** of payment of fees and submission of documents

Step 5: Approval and issuance of Road Worthiness Certification

Successful applicants are issued a Road Worthiness Certificate (RWC) within **3 hours** of completion of inspection.
